Dr. Hendricks is also author of the critically acclaimed novel, *Living Water*, inspired by the biblical story of the woman at the well. He has served as a professor at Drew University, as visiting scholar at Princeton Theological Seminary, and as President of Payne Theological Seminary, the oldest African American theological institution in the United States.
